Harvestime International Prison Ministries

"I was in prison, and you came unto me"...(Matthew 25:26)

For twenty years now, Harvestime has been involved in jail and prison ministries around the globe. We minister personally in various institutions conducting Bible studies, church services, and Harvestime Institutes. We also provide materials to inmates and chaplains and our *Jail and Prison Ministry* training manual has been instrumental in raising up prison ministries around the world. This month's CO-OP is a sampling of reports from inmates and institutions receiving the training.

From Sri Lanka: "I was incarcerated for a year. Upon my release, the Holy Spirit connected me to Brother Dilan and brought me under his ministry. Together, we pioneered a prison ministry, bringing hope to the hopeless. During the first 12 months, we led 325 prisoners to Christ." R.K. (*Brother Dilan is the minister heading our Sinhala and Tamil translation and the Institute that is training national Christian leaders throughout the Island of Sri Lanka.*)

From California: "I still sing the songs you used to play in prison.... that's pretty cool. I work for Hospice, attend church, and do jail ministry with Women's Aglow. I love you guys and you have to know you helped save my life when you brought the love of Jesus to me. I will always be grateful." Former inmate, R.O.

From Florida: "I am the faith-based chaplain here at a correctional facility in Milton, Florida. We have 2000 inmates in the facility and 70 inmates in the faith-based dorm. We have a new senior chaplain and he asked me to look at your materials for the men here. I read your doctrinal statement and found it biblical and straight forward. I appreciated that very much. I would like to start an institute here if possible. I believe that it would be a tremendous asset to this campus and will help these 2000 men to deepen their walk with Christ." C.B.
